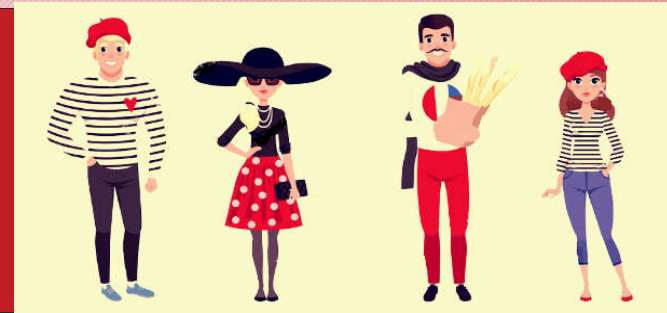

SUMMER COURSES OF FRENCH LANGUAGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME

- Apply in February at your university
- Results in May
- Go in July or August to France

Type of courses

What? Intensive summer course of French language

Where? In a university or a language center
acknowledged by the French Consulate and bearing
French as a Foreign Language Quality label FLE

Duration: 4 weeks between June and September

Number of course hours: 72 to 120 h

Value of scholarship: 5000 MOP

Criteria of eligibility

- Enrolled in a university in Macau or Hong Kong in 2018-2019
- A non-native French speaker
- Aged 18 or above
- Currently enrolled in a course not lower than level A2
- Have taken at least one semester in the French program in the last two years
- Attending the scholarship ceremony organized by the Consulate General of France and Legion d`Honneur Club in November 2019

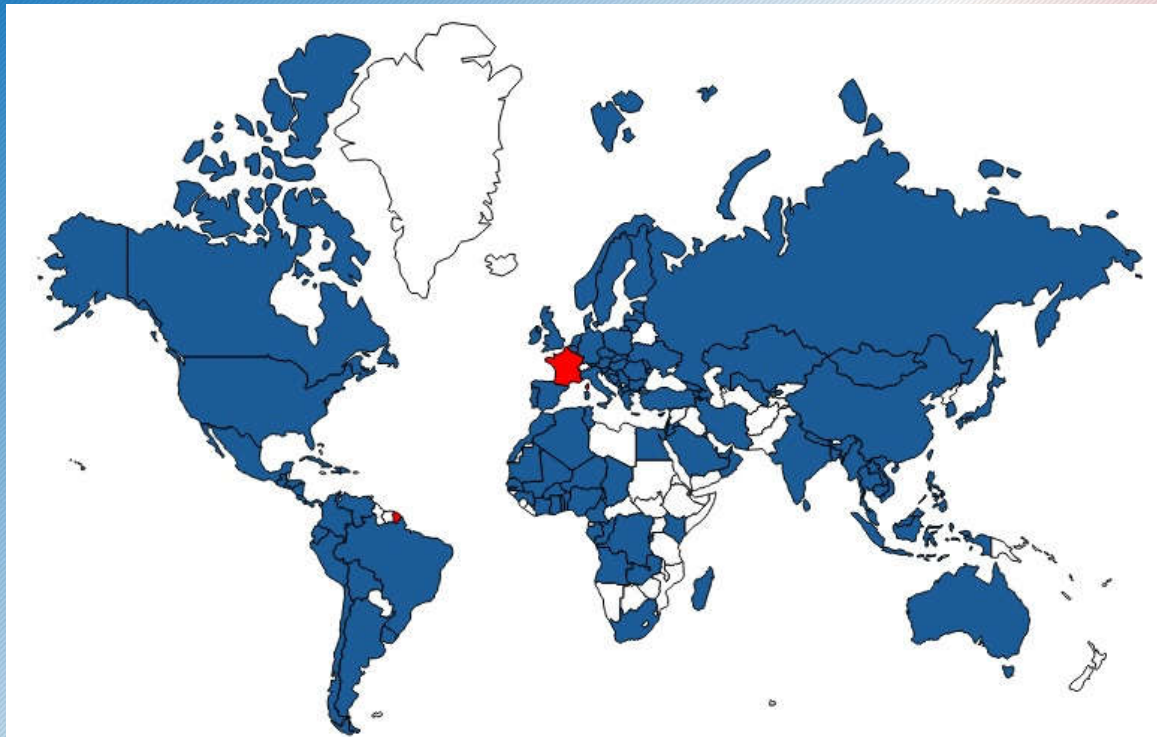

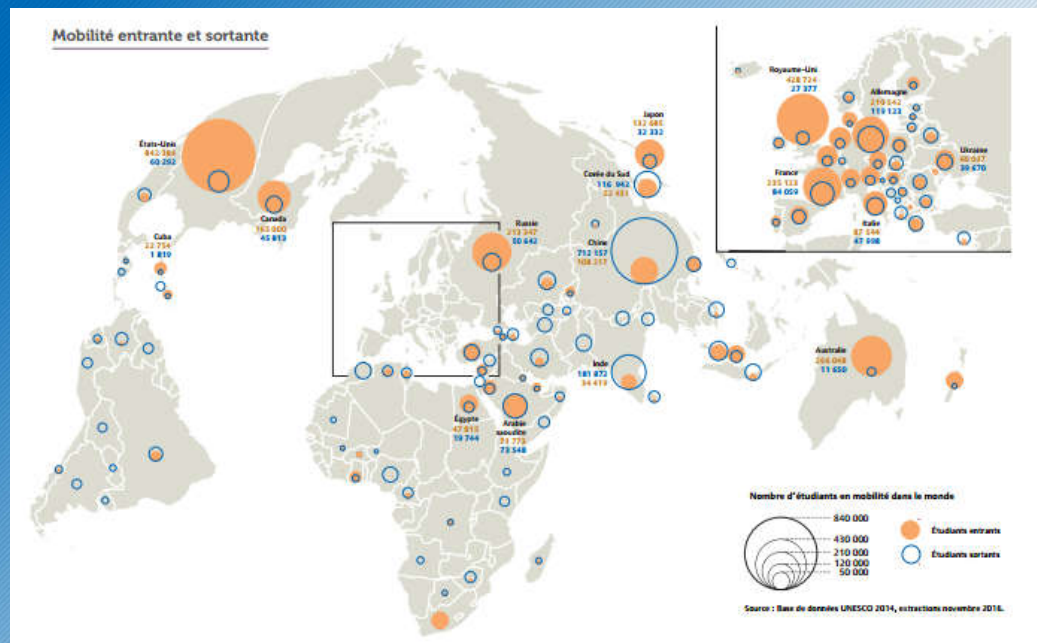

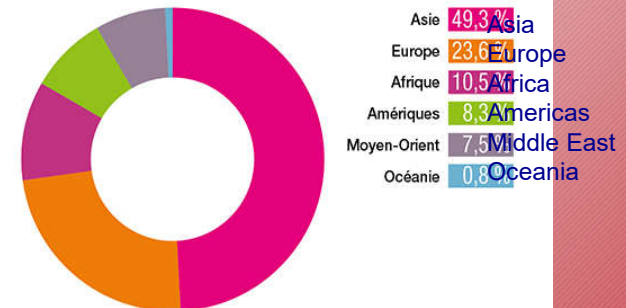

◆ Various housing solutions are available

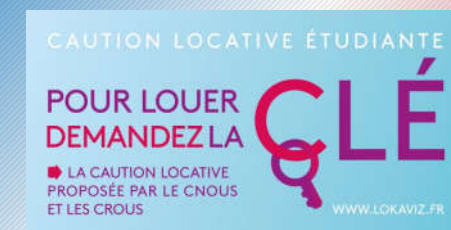
- ✓ University housing (Cités-U)
- ✓ Private buildings designed for students
- ✓ Rentals in the private housing market
- ✓ Group rentals
- ✓ Intergenerational housing
- ✓ Residencies (e.g., for medical students)

◆ Housing subsidies

- ✓ Available to international students on the same terms as French students
- ✓ Subsidies vary with rental cost
- ✓ Available even for group rentals

◆ CLE: guarantees for student renters

- ✓ Government guarantees are available to student renters who have no personal guarantor
- ✓ Available in all of France's academic regions except overseas territories and departments



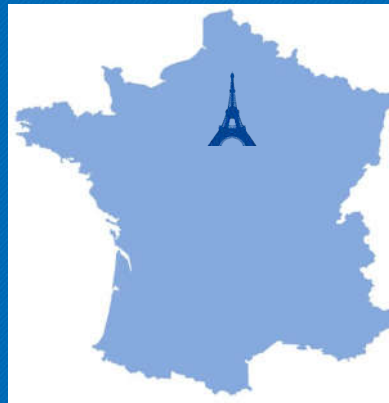

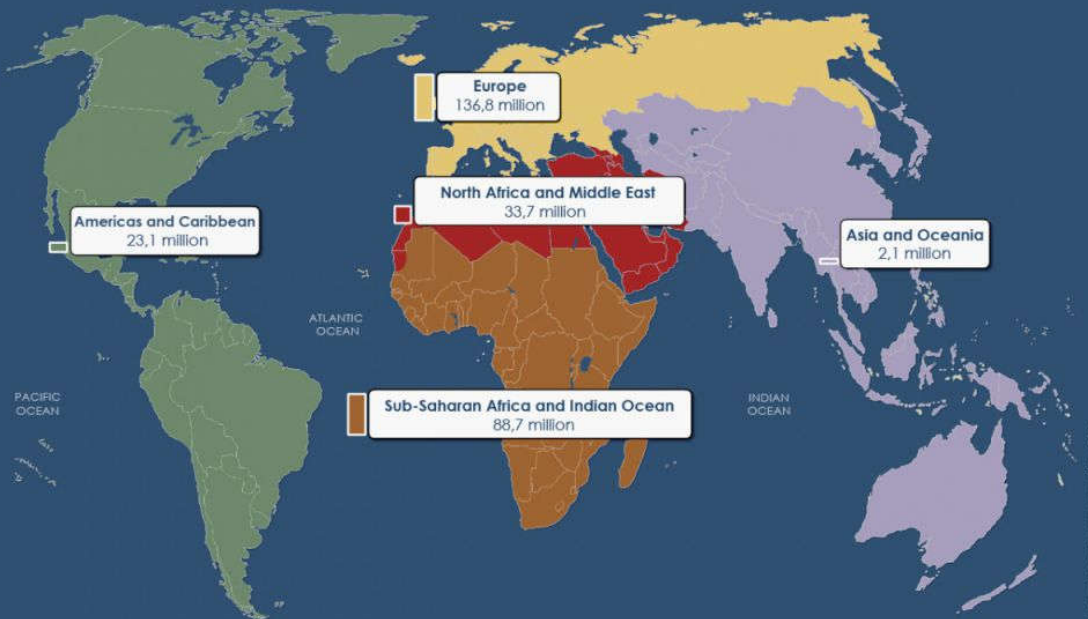
