Scholarship Guidelines for UM's Outgoing Exchange Students

[For Undergraduate Programmes Only]

Scholarships mentioned in these guidelines are those scholarships offered by organizations or individuals intended for UM undergraduate students and are selected mainly based on academic performance. Starting from 2010/2011 academic year, UM outgoing exchange students are eligible for scholarships provided that they meet the requirements of the following guidelines.

The scholarship guidelines stated here are intended to apply to all <u>undergraduate</u> students who have joined the UM outgoing exchange programmes in the academic year <u>2021/2022</u>. To be eligible for the scholarships, the students should:

- 1. fulfill the exchange study plan which they have agreed with the faculty before they go abroad; and
- 2. achieve an overall result of Grade B, 3.0 on the 4-point GPA scale, or 13 on the 20-point scale at the exchange university. If the exchange university does not adopt any of these grading systems, the faculty could decide whether the student achieves such requirement based on the grading system adopted by the exchange university; and
- 3. submit academic records of exchange university to his/her own faculty in UM by <u>16th</u> <u>August 2022</u>.

If the above 3 requirements are fulfilled, the scholarship assessment would be based on the students' academic result achieved at UM accordingly.

- For students joining the <u>one-year exchange programme</u>, scholarship assessment would be based on their yearly GPA achieved at UM in the previous academic year.
- For students joining the <u>one-semester exchange programme</u>, scholarship assessment would be based on their GPA achieved in the semester at UM in the exchange academic year.
