Assistant Professor / Senior Instructor Macau Law

The University of Macau (UMacau) is the flagship public university in Macao, which gives it a unique advantage in pursuing the goal of becoming a world-class university with regional characteristics. The Faculty of Law (FLL) invites applications for the position of Assistant Professor/Senior Instructor in the area of Macau Law.

The Faculty of Law of University of Macau is the oldest law school in Macao and plays a very important role in preparing jurists who are familiar with Macao S.A.R. legal system, as well as, educating jurists who are competent in legal research and practices in Macau law, international law and comparative law. The Faculty of Law presently offers undergraduate degrees and postgraduate degrees to both local and international students.

Qualifications

Applications for the post of Assistant Professor must hold a PhD degree in Law while applicants for the post of Senior Instructor must hold a Master degree in Law (PhD degree preferable). Preference will be given to applicants with teaching experience and strong evidence of research achievement, which shall be substantiated by publication in refereed journals of international standing. Applicants must be bilingual and able to teach or do research in Portuguese-English or Portuguese-Chinese.

The selected candidate is expected to assume duty in January 2018.

Position and Remuneration

Remuneration and appointment rank offered will be competitive and commensurate with the successful applicants' academic qualification, current position and professional experience. The current local maximum income tax rate is 12% but is effectively around 5% - 7% after various discretionary exemptions.
